Proposal content and format

Proposals should be 4 pages long formatted in a single-column text in PDF. They should include the following information

- Title of the proposed tutorial
- Names and affiliations of tutorial presenters
- Area of the tutorial (refer to the above list of topics)
- Abstract (300-words long, aimed for publicity and inclusion in registration booklet)
- Keywords
- Target audience and prerequisite knowledge
- Learning objectives
- Table of contents
- Detailed description of teaching modules and sections

Appendices

- Instructor's credentials: 4-page CV for each instructor, including selected publications relevant to the proposed tutorial topic and list of tutorials given at other conferences
